## SAFOTO International Photography Festival

Bill's exhibit for FotoSeptiembre USA (a work of [SAFOTO International Photography Festival](#)), is called "*Art In the Garden*." The exhibition opens Saturday, September 1, at the Antique Rose Emporium in San Antonio ([7561 East Evans Road](#)), and will run through the end of the month. Hours are: 9-5 each Saturday, and 11-5 each Sunday. The show can also be opened for special private viewing, by appointment (call Dawn at 210-355-8097). If you are interested in attending the special reception near the middle of the month, please call Dawn as well.

The FotoSeptiembre show catalogs are available in limited supply from Bill. The catalogs have been exceptionally produced and contain full show information for each of the thirty exhibitors, along with sample color photographs from each (including Bill's show). This year, FotoSeptiembre has exhibits in **Paris, Reggio-Emilia (Italy), Mexico City, Singapore, New Delhi, the Canary Islands**, and twenty two exhibits in South Texas (mostly in San Antonio) .
