Authoring books of poetry as well as historical novels for young adults, his writing has been the recipient of the <u>Texas Library Association</u>'s Lone Star Book Award.

He was the founding editor of literary magazines, Pax: A Journal for Peace through Culture and Vortex: A Critical Review. Recent publications include two illustrated children's books, "Brigid's Cloak: An Ancient Irish Story" brog Magia Stallione."

A two-time finalist at the Kerrville New Folks Songwriting contest, Milligan will soon release a CD of his songs, "Muse Lore: Ten Thousand Mornings After."

Milligan has been the publisher/editor of <u>Wings Press</u> since 1995.

In addition to honoring Milligan, INKstravaganza will celebrate Gemini Ink's dedication of nurturing readers, writers, and thinkers throughout both San Antonio and South Texas.

The event will be held at the historic Pearl Stable with cocktails and music at 6:30 p.m. and dinner at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$100 per person.

INKstravaganza will showcase a FOTOSEPTIEMBRE USA exhibition and silent auction, featuring photos by local photographers, as well as live music. Jazz elites George and <u>Aaron Prado</u> will provide music.
