Fotoseptiembre is an international biennial celebration of photography, conceived and organized by the Centro de la Imagen - Latin America's foremost photographic institution - in Mexico City. The original edition of Fotoseptiembre, in 1994, was created to provide a forum and a context for Mexican photographers to show and discuss their work. The event grew rapidly, generating interest throughout Latin America and the USA. Fotoseptiembre 1996 prompted the staging of over 560 exhibits and conferences throughout the Americas, with a strong contingent of events in Texas. Now, in the spirit of fostering a truly global photographic community, Fotoseptiembre Internacional 1998 has become a festival with a roster of over 700 photography related events, that take place during the months of August, September and October of 1998, throughout North and South America, Europe, Asia and Australia.

The events listed in this calendar are a microcosm, a true sampling, of the scope and depth of Fotoseptiembre Internacional 1998. Most of these exhibits are located in San Antonio, Texas. Others are sited in galleries and institutions in Austin, Houston, Boston and New York City. All these events reflect on the commitment and interest of their organizers; who have shown an understanding of the importance of the links that are forged through events like Fotoseptiembre, and who share a willingness to help shape the future of photography as the primary art medium of the 21st century.

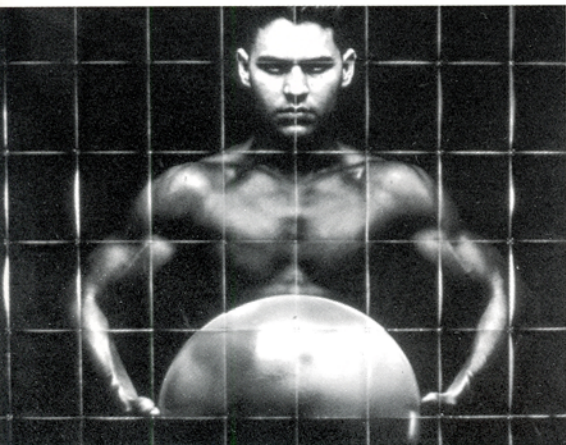
